Norway in the Winter Olympics

1. In 2022, Norway surpassed 400 medals—a total of 405!
2. Most medals in a single Olympic (39). 2022: Most gold medals in a single Olympics (16).
3. Norway has won 9 Winter Olympic Games.
4. Cross-Country Skiing: Norway has won 129 medals in Cross-Country Skiing, ahead of Sweden in 2nd place with 84 medals.
5. Marit Bjørgen: 15 medals (2002-2018). Bjørn Dæhlie 12 medals (1992-1998).
